

# Classroom Safety

## In the Classroom, we will:

- remove toys and objects which cannot be easily cleaned
- use touchless trash cans
- keep comfort items in a cubby or bin
- rearrange seating
- ensure teaching staff wear masks
- tape off drinking fountains and provide disposable drinking cups
- wash hands frequently
- clean and disinfect frequently

## School-Wide, we will:

- send anyone who becomes symptomatic home immediately
- isolate people who become ill while in care but can't leave immediately in a safe location
- limit, or eliminate, use of common spaces
- wear masks in any remaining common spaces
- ensure appropriate ventilation
- tape off drinking fountains and provide disposable drinking cups
- clean and disinfect frequently

# Fall Learning Plan 2020-2021



This brochure will help to guide your family through the transitions between **Distance Learning** and **Hybrid Learning\*** as we change phases during the COVID-19 pandemic.

*\*Hybrid learning is Part-time in class,  
Part-time Distance Learning.*



## Learning Model

### Distance Learning

*Full time remote learning*

- Teachers will provide weekly lessons via the Seesaw App.
- Does not require commuting.
- Meals & snacks will be provided.
- Students will have individualized schedules.

## ALL Programs

- Your Teacher/Home Visitor will connect with families via phone, Zoom, and/or Seesaw App .
- A developmentally appropriate distance learning curriculum will be provided.
- Children are encouraged to participate in the weekly virtual visits.
- The teacher/Home Visitor and family will address family needs and plan activities together to support the family and child.

## Program-Specific

### Infant/Toddler & Home Visiting:

- Teachers/Home Visitors will meet virtually with families once a week.

### Preschool:

- Teachers will be in communication with families Monday-Friday.
- Distance Learning Material Kit provided to each student.

## Learning Model

### Hybrid-Learning

*Part-time in-classroom, part-time Distance Learning (as above)*

- **Families may choose to continue with full-time Distance Learning in Phase 4.**
- Teachers will provide weekly lessons via the Seesaw App.
- Transportation is available for those living within boundaries.
- Meals & snacks will be provided.
- Children will be in person (if the family chooses) for two 5-hour days.

## ALL Programs

- Class sizes are limited to eight children and two teachers.
- Children will participate in developmentally appropriate routines and activities.
- Class groups attend class either Monday/Tuesday or Thursday/Friday. Centers are closed Wednesdays for deep-cleaning between groups.

## Program-Specific

### Infant/Toddler Only:

- Children will be on-site (if the family chooses) for 5½ hours, 4 days a week.
- Families can choose to enroll in our in-person classes or change to our Home Visiting Program program.

### Home Visiting only:

- Families can choose weekly virtual or in-person outdoor visits (in the yard, park, playground, etc.)
- When meeting in-person, all adults will wear masks, complete a health screener, and everyone will maintain 6 feet of physical distance.

### Preschool:

- Children will be on-site (if the family chooses) for 5 hours, 2 days a week.
- Distance Learning material kit provided to each student.
