Low-Cost and Free Summer Activities

1. **Volunteer at Kids Food Basket** – kids 5 years and older are encouraged to help out
2. **Grand Rapids Public Library** – Join the Summer Reading Challenge -pick up a Summer Reading Challenge passport and complete reading challenges designed for all ages
3. **Explore the Parks** – there are so many great parks in our city, some even have streams/creeks to explore as well. Some great parks include Fallsburg Park, Roselle Park, Millennium Park, Rosewood Park, Pinewood Park, Hagar Park, Versluis Park and many more.
4. **GRR Observation Park** – enjoy a picnic while watching the planes fly in and out of the airport!
5. **Visit various Farmers Markets** and pick out some local produce. You can use your Double Up Food Bucks and get other items for just \$1 when you use your SNAP/Bridge Card benefits
6. **John Ball Zoo** – free admission for up to 9 people when you use your Bridge Card. You will need to show your ID with your Bridge Card at the ticket window
7. **Movies in the Park** – East Grand Rapids and the Yankee Clipper Library are hosting Movies in the Park this summer! Bring a lawn chair, drinks and snacks and enjoy a movie outside with the family <https://grkids.com/outdoor-concerts-movies-in-the-park/>
8. **Grand Rapids Children’s Museum** - \$1.75 admission per person when you present your Bridge Card
9. **Kids Bowl Free** – Many bowling alley’s allow kids to bowl 2 games for free each. Register and see the locations here: <https://grkids.com/kids-bowl-free/>
10. **Visit a Public Splash Pad or Pool** – there are so many great splash pads and pools around that are free
