The Importance of Schedules and Routines

Familiar activities can provide comfort for both adults and children. Just like adults, children feel more confident and secure when their daily activities are predictable and familiar. A consistent daily schedule and step by step routines give children a predictable day.

Schedules and routines help children:

- Feel in control of their environment
- Feel safe, secure, and comfortable
- Know what is happening now and what comes next
- Know how to do an activity or task
- Engage in learning

Recognizing what comes next in a routine is an early math skill. Babies start to recognize the sequence of events early on. For example, when they hear the bath water running they know it's bath time. When you ask your toddler to get their coat, they know outside comes next!
